east | CATCH

For a maritime experience on the east coast, visit New York's Catch, unveiled late last year by the EMM Group. Situated in a three-story loft-like space designed by ICrave, the interiors are built around the performance of *Top Chef* winner Hung Huynh's tasty dishes from the sea with sleek elements that include a stacked-timber-and-metal staircase, marble-topped bars, brick and copper accents, and incandescent lighting that sets the space aglow.
