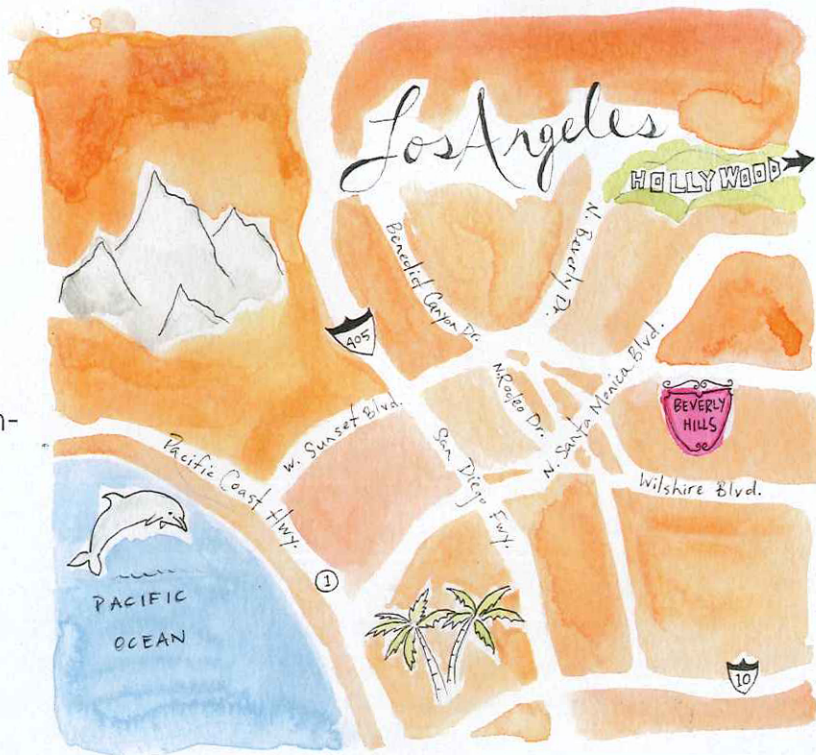




# LOS ANGELES

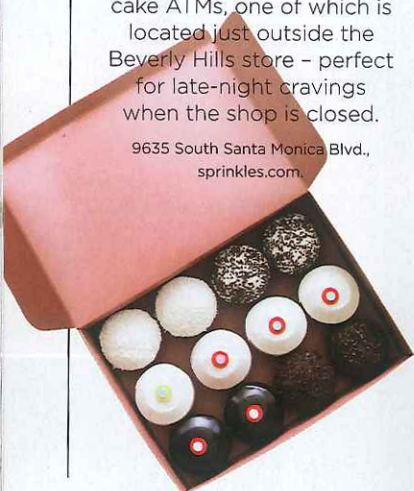
